Plant Nutrition meets social expectations of sustainable plant production

Social expectations concerning agricultural and horticultural plant production are subject to constant change. Current priorities include environmental friendliness, resilience to the adverse impacts of natural and man-made stresses, and healthiness of food. At this year's Annual Meeting of the German Society of Plant nutrition, which will take place from

September 25 – 27 in Berlin,

both oral and poster presentations are welcome which show findings of Plant Nutrition in the research fields of

- environmental friendly plant nutrition (e.g., nutrient efficiencies, rhizosphere processes, symbioses, fertilizer and fertilization technology, etc.)
- yield stability (e.g., resilience to nutrient deficiencies, salinity, acidity, climate change, etc.)
- healthiness of food (e.g., biofortification, toxic minerals, bioactive compounds, etc.)

In all these fields, we expect a wide range of contributions, which cover the diversity of Plant Nutrition's experimental approaches to study processes from the subcellular to the field level. For each of these research fields, we intend to invite one key note speaker (international expert). In addition, we look for an expert outside from Plant Nutrition, who might present social expectations.

The Berlin-Marathon will take place from September 28-29. Therefore, it is necessary to **book hotel rooms as early as possible** (see attachment). The conference venue will be Invalidenstraße 42, 10115 Berlin. The lecture program will start on September 25 from 13:00, and end on September 27 at 13:00. On Friday afternoon, an excursion will be offered to the Leibniz Institut für Gemüse- und Zierpflanzenbau in Großbeeren (ending at 17.00).
